Description

The Technical Officer reports directly to the Principal CNS.

Duties and Responsibilities

1. Ensure that the voice recorder is operating to standard operational conditions and change discs if required
2. Responsible for all airports general equipment;
3. Responsible for all communications within the airport;
4. Assist Electrical Officer with Air Field Lights electronic facilities;
5. Ensure telephone systems are functioning at all times;
6. Submit written reports of daily operations to Senior Technical Officer;
7. Ensure daily checks of Fault Register at the tower is done and report the Principal CNS;
8. Any other task and duties as directed by Principal from time to time

Qualifications

- (a) At least 1 year of proven technical work or relevant experience in maintenance.
- (b) Must be a qualified Technician.
- (c) Must hold University Entrance with good passes in Mathematics, Physics and English.
- (d) Must hold a Diploma of Radio and Electronic from National University of Samoa (IOT-NUS).
- (e) General knowledge of SAA history and background and legislations and policies governing SAA work will be an advantage.
